

EVALUATING POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS



GRADE 11 LESSON 30



Time Required: 30-45 minutes

Content Standards: Students will complete school with the academic rigor and preparation essential to choose from a wide range of substantial postsecondary options, including college.

Indicators (Students will...): Students will discuss the current relationship between flexible career plans, post-secondary goals, five year HS course plans, report card, grades, standardized test scores, and academic improvement plans, and revise each as appropriate.

GOAL: Students will explore educational opportunities after high school.

Activity Statements: Some students may not be planning to go to college or seek any training immediately after high school and may think this lesson is not for them. You need to inform them that they may change their mind when they become working adults and find out they can get a better job if they get more education. They also need to develop these skills to help others, particularly their own children when they begin looking at their educational options.
